1	Cystoscopy	Including ureteral catheterization by injecting materials under the ureter or by placing a permanent ureteral stent	\$500
2	PCCL	Endoscopic suprapubic bladder stone breaking or removal	\$1100
3	Nephrectomy	Including incomplete ureterostomy, by any method, including removal of the kidney	\$2500
4	Prostatectomy	suprapubic, or retropubic, complete or semi-complete, one or two stages, including postoperative bleeding control during the first hospitalization, complete includes vasectomy, mesothelioma, urethral calibration or dilatation, and internal urethrotomy	\$3000
5	RIRS	kidney stone laser surgery without any incisions on the body. It is an endoscopic surgery and performed through the natural orifice.	\$1900

7	TUL	Transurethral Lithotripsy, is an effective method for crushing stones that are stuck in the ureter.	\$1100
8	URETHROSCOPY	examination of the interior of the urethra, and sometimes also the bladder, using a ureteroscope, which is a very small camera on the end of a rigid or flexible probe.	\$1000

1	Meniscectomy	Surgical removal of a meniscus, especially that of the knee	\$1500
2	Total Knee Arthroscopy (TKA)	A surgical procedure to resurface a knee damaged by arthritis. Metal and plastic parts are used to cap the ends of the bones that form the knee joint, along with the kneecap.	\$3400
3	Total Hip Arthroscopy (THA)	A surgical procedure in which the hip joint is replaced by a prosthetic implant, that is, a hip prosthesis. Hip replacement surgery can be performed as a total replacement or a hemi/semi replacement.	\$2500
4	Carpal Tunnel Syndrome (One hand)	Open surgery and endoscopic surgery. Your surgeon makes a cut near the bottom of your palm. They'll use a special knife to divide your carpal ligament. This will widen the carpal tunnel and ease pressure on your median nerve.	\$1100

2	Discectomy	Is done through a 1/2 inch or larger skin opening) is the surgical removal of abnormal disc material.	\$2000
